

Lost and Found

All found items are to be turned over to the Business Office. If the Business Office is closed, the article will be accepted by the switchboard and turned over to the Business Office the next morning.

At the end of each semester, all unclaimed items will be donated to Interfaith Campus Ministry or discarded, as appropriate. Books will be turned over to the bookstore.

Security Escort

For your comfort and peace of mind, you may call Stark Campus Security for an escort to your vehicle or a building on campus. Contact campus security by dialing 330-705-0430 from any phone. You may also dial "53123" from any campus phone.

- Anytime you feel you need assistance

Please Note: Security will not open car doors or change tires.

Vehicles on Campus

If your vehicle's battery needs a jump, Kent State Stark Security will assist you. Contact campus security by dialing 330-705-0430 from any phone. You may also dial "53123" from any campus phone.



A 15-mph speed limit is in effect for the campus parking areas. A 25-mph speed limit is in effect for all campus roadways. **Drivers must yield to pedestrians at all times.** Anyone found operating a vehicle recklessly on campus or without regard for the safety of others will be issued a traffic violation and may be subject to disciplinary action.

Disability Parking

Clearly marked disability parking spaces have been established at various locations around the campus. See the map on the reverse side of this brochure for specific locations. A state-issued disability parking placard or plate is required and must be properly displayed in order to park in these areas. Upon application, the State of Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles issues permits for both temporary disabilities (lasting six months or less) and permanent disabilities. Ask your personal physician or other health care provider to assist you with the application process.

Kent State University at Stark strives to maintain a safe environment for the students, staff and faculty. To better serve the campus community, specific guidelines have been established.

KENT STATE UNIVERSITY AT STARK PARKING INFORMATION

All drivers, except campus visitors, are required to display permits in their vehicles to park at Kent State University at Stark. Each lot is designated with signage to indicate parking for students, faculty and staff, in addition to visitors.

Students park free of charge **with a Stark or Kent Campus parking permit** in all designated student lots. Although adequate parking is provided on campus as a whole, it does not guarantee a parking space immediately adjacent to the building in which a student has class. **Note: Stark Campus parking permits are not valid for parking at the Kent Campus.**

A permit is mailed to each registered student. If lost or stolen, replacement student parking permits may be obtained from the Business Office, located in Main Hall room 128.

If a vehicle is parked in an unauthorized lot, it may be given a violation sticker. VIOLATION stickers are placed on the lower right-hand corner of the driver's side window in lieu of a monetary fine.

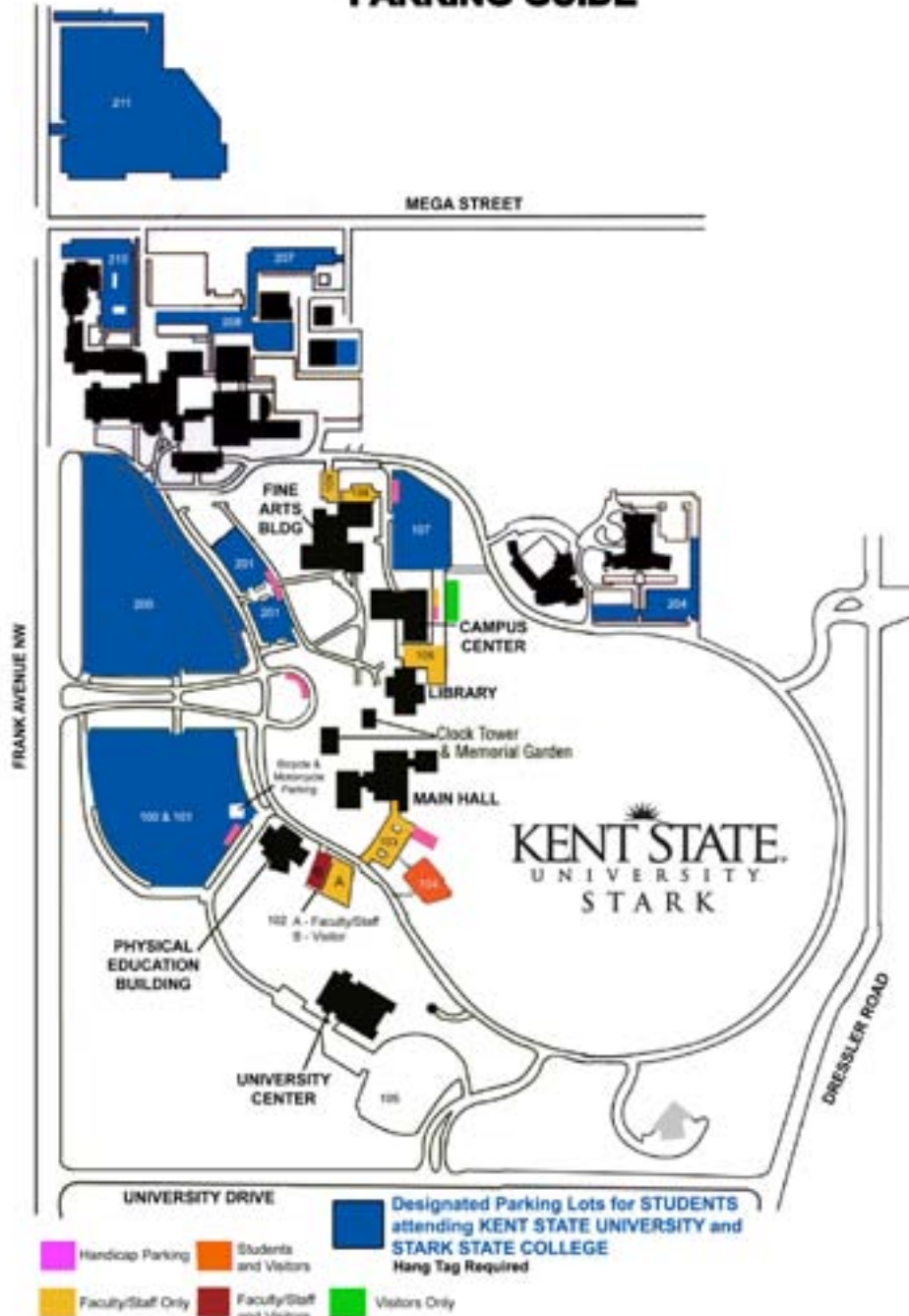

Student vehicles must display a KSU (Stark or Kent Campus) parking permit and be parked in a designated space or risk receiving a VIOLATION sticker by Campus Security.

Parking violation stickers will be issued to illegally parked vehicles. Parking violations include, but are not limited to:

- parking in a space designated as handicapped without an up-to-date state handicapped permit;
- utilizing more than one parking space;
- parking in an area designated as faculty/staff parking without the proper permit;
- parking in a space other than a designated parking area;
- parking an oversized or recreational vehicle, boat or trailer on campus without permission;
- leaving a vehicle on campus overnight without prior permission.
- parking on playing fields, on the grass or on curb sides;
- motorcycles parked on asphalt without the use of a kickstand disk; and
- bicycles not parked in designated racks.

KENT STATE UNIVERSITY AT STARK PARKING GUIDE



Kent State University at Stark provides free parking for students, faculty and staff with required parking permits. Campus visitors must park in the designated visitor lots. Visit www.stark.kent.edu/about/offices/businessoffice/parking for further information.

Please use the map to the left as a guide for parking on campus.

Vehicles with a properly displayed State of Ohio disability tag may park in designated disability parking spaces with or without a student parking permit.

Vehicles that are parked in restricted lots and spaces without a visible permit may receive a violation sticker.

CAMPUS SECURITY PHONES



Kent State Stark is equipped with campus phones in the parking lots for your safety. If you have an emergency and need immediate assistance, press the 911 button to be connected to the local safety center. The phone can also be used to contact anyone

on campus, using their campus extensions. These phones are not capable of calling off-campus.

Security can be notified on campus from any campus phone by dialing "53123." Security can also be contacted directly by cell phone at 330-705-0430 after normal operating hours.

The campus emergency phones are located at the following locations: Conference Center, rear; Main Hall, west lot, north and south ends; Main Hall, east lot; Pond; Campus Center, rear; Fine Arts, rear.
